PUBLIC NOTICE - NOTICE FOR INVITATION TO BID

Susquehanna Area Regional Airport Authority (SARAA) shall receive bids via PennBid for the bidding of Harrisburg International Airport (MDT) EXPAND CARGO APRON, PHASE VI (AIRCRAFT PARKING APRON) until **2:00 PM, Tuesday, July 9, 2024**, at which time they will be opened online and publicly posted via PennBid.

All documents and solicitation details are available at no cost on PennBid – www.PennBid.net

The work site is located at the Harrisburg International Airport in Middletown, Pennsylvania. Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents. The work is generally described as follows:

Expand Cargo Apron, Phase VI (Aircraft Parking Apron). This Aircraft Parking Apron project (Phase VI) is part of a multi-year, multi-construction package program underway at HIA to expand the airport's cargo operation.

The prior work, Drainage and New Outfall project (Phase IV) consisted of drainage installation from Taxiway G to the Susquehanna River and is completed under separate contract by Others for a new drainage system complete from south of Taxiway G to the river outfall culvert through the flood dike.

The prior work, Drainage and Apron project (Phase V) consisted of drainage construction from Taxiway G upstream to the new Cargo Apron expansion including the new cargo apron trench drain, glycol diversion vault, oil/water separator, oil/water diversion vault. The project also included the construction of the southern portion of the new cargo apron expansion to past the trench drain. This work is underway via a separate contract by Others and will be completed by November 2024. All work shown in these documents shall be considered as existing conditions.

This project is the final phase of the Expand Cargo Apron program, Aircraft Parking Apron (Phase VI), and includes construction of the northern portion of the new cargo apron expansion and will include construction of a new 17" concrete pavement section atop a stabilized base on an aggregate base in what is an existing grassed infield area, complete with new GSE asphalt pavement. The project will tie into the Phase V project to the south, the existing cargo apron to the east, and the existing Taxilane H pavement to the west. The project includes proposed drainage construction to include reinforced concrete pipe to the northern limits of the proposed cargo apron for infield and GSE drainage and future drainage by others. This project also includes high mast lighting and mass site and utility demolition. The project includes specific detailed construction phases to minimize impacts to airport operations and allow the landside construction of the northern portion of the new cargo apron expansion.

Bidders are to **schedule a Site Visit** with SARAA's Engineering Office by following the instructions to bidders.

Bidders are advised that a virtual **Pre-Bid Meeting** will be held **Thursday, June 6, 2024 at 1:00 P.M.** Link will be provided on PennBid. Any questions or interpretations of the documents must be submitted in writing via PennBid following the instructions to bidders.

Each bid submitted must be accompanied by a **Bid Security in the amount of ten percent (10%)** of the total bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof unless award is delayed due to the required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or the award of grant(s); in which case, bids shall be irrevocable for one hundred twenty (120) calendar days in compliance with Act 317 of 1978 approved November 26, 1978.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Surety Bond and a Payment Bond each in the full amount of the Contract Price.

Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive any and all informalities and the right to reject all nonconforming, non-responsive or conditional Bids, in the Owner's sole discretion.
